Jude Olesen says their guests have the ability to get up at 5 am and go for a nature walk or sleep in late if they are on a romantic getaway. Neither of which will cause them to miss breakfast because there is no set time for it. Each apartment is stocked with breakfast foods that the guests can prepare and eat at their own leisure using their own kitchenette.

The manager says that one of the main attractions for those that stay with them is taking a walk in Brancaster Staithe. Jude says that Brancaster Staithe is one of the nicest coastal villages in all of the UK. It is very close to an abundance of open beaches, bird watching reserves, harbour and other scenic areas. There are also many stately manors in the area which have open grounds or feature tours of the property. Attractions that are within walking distance include The Harbour, The Norfolk Coastal Path, The Crab Hut, The White Horse, and the Dalegate Market which includes a Local Supermarket and Filling Station. Jude Olesen also said one of the areas most popular pubs, The Jolly Sailors, is located close by to Brancaster Stays.

Nearby attractions also include several well-known golf courses, tennis clubs, and places where one can get a boat ride to go seal watching or fishing. The area also has some of the best upscale and casual restaurants that can be found on England?s east coast.
