Aside from pipe leaks, common water damage events may also result from toilet overflow, faulty water heat,

For ground water seepage, homeowners are advised not to call their insurance company until the water damage and its cause have been determined by a dependable restoration company. This is because it is not usually covered on most insurance policies. However, some minute details can make a difference.

Daryl Olsen points out that it may be a good idea at times for homeowners not to hire the insurance company's preferred water damage mitigation company.
