As Bio Clean of Utah points out, it is a fact that molds produce allergens and irritants that, when exposed to people, can cause them to experience symptoms that are similar to hay fever. The symptoms can include sneezing, runny noses, skin rashes, irritated eyes as well as nose, throat and lung ailments, and these health risks are only a few of the reasons why homeowners should be concerned about mold. Other symptoms associated with mold include burning eyes, blurred vision, respiratory illness, chest pains, chest tightness, shortness of breath, wheezing, dry cough, nasal congestion, aggravated asthma and cognitive disorder.

The company further explains that many toxic molds, including black mold, produce poisonous substances called mycotoxins that interfere with cell structures and processes and have the potential to cause serious

health issues. Their effects on the body have been documented using controlled conditions in a laboratory and proven to be present indoors, with victims suffering from pulmonary hemorrhage or pulmonary hemosiderosis (primarily in infants), headaches and other flu-like symptoms, nose bleeds, hair loss, chronic fatigue, dermatitis and more.

Daryl Olsen, a representative for Bio Clean of Utah, says, "Obviously, there are more than enough reasons for someone not to want to live with mold in their houses. If you have mold, or believe you have mold, the first thing to do is get your house inspected. We can come on site and perform an inspection, taking into consideration the history of the property, current dampness, the moisture source, affected materials, and suspected affected areas. We have a lot of expertise with mold detection and removal as well as a variety of moisture detection meters and devices."

He continues, "After we do the initial inspection, we can do a proper testing to measure and document the quantity and varieties of mold in the air, as they are very small and virtually invisible to the naked eye. This type of information can be helpful in determining the scope of work necessary, documenting the results of the mold removal and proving that the space is clean and safe. At that point, we can do the work to remove the mold and make your house safe again."

Mold is most prolific between 65°F and 85°F, according to the company. Building interiors can provide a "prime" environment for growth and reproduction of mold, mildew and bacteria. All molds are parasitic and rely on organic matter for food. Mold breaks down organic matter and its food sources include materials such as wood, paper, drywall, paneling and ceiling tiles. Decaying organic jute backing on carpets, coupled with warm humid air, also creates an ideal environment for reproduction.
