Daryl Olsen, the Mr. Chem-Dry Centerville franchise owner, had this to say about their green carpet cleaning method, "We are proud of the fact that we use all-natural means to clean our customers' carpets. Our green carpet cleaning method uses no soap or detergents and is 100% non-toxic too. What's even more remarkable is how well it works. That means we are able to give our customers the best of both worlds when we clean their carpets for them."

Olsen says that of course, the biggest reason anyone would want to go green when they get their carpeting cleaned is because of how safe it is for the occupants of a home. If a company uses toxic chemicals when cleaning carpets there is no way they can remove them 100% when they extract the solution. He says that

means that carpeting may then not be safe for infants, pets, and others who come into contact with it. The franchise owner says that it is something that their customers will never have to worry about. Olsen also pointed out that carpet cleaning solutions with more toxic chemicals have the potential to wear down fibers in carpet and upholstery much faster than gentle non-toxic carpet cleaning solutions like they use. They even heat their solution up to 230 degrees before it's applied over carpeting. That takes that carpeting's health safety one step further by removing 98% of the allergens and 89% of airborne bacteria that are present in it.

According to Olsen, the green carpet cleaning method that they use also takes far less water than companies that use more toxic carpet cleaning solutions. He says in many cases their carpet cleaning method will use up to 80% less water than other types of professional carpet cleaning methods do. The franchise owner says that makes their carpet cleaning method much more environmentally friendly. When that is factored in along with the use of their PowerHead Machine® that also has a patented Amplified Extraction system, it also significantly reduces drying time. He says many times the carpeting that they clean is ready to walk on again after just a few hours.

Olsen says that their green carpet cleaning services are often cheaper than their competitors too. That's because the ingredients in more toxic types of solutions make them more expensive. He says that since their carpet cleaning method only uses inexpensive carbonated water to lift out soil and stains, they can keep the cost of their services very reasonable. A majority of the time, their estimates are less than that of their competition when they bid against them head to head.

The franchise owner says that getting carpet professionally cleaned by them has other benefits too. He mentioned that one of them is the fact that it often enhances the feeling of any carpet it's done on.
