Degenerative arthritis is a type of arthritis that results from the breakdown, inflammation, and gradual loss of the cartilage of the joints. It is the most common form of arthritis and affects the hands, spine, feet, and weight-bearing joints like the hips and knees. This results in pain and stiffness and the pain could be sufficiently severe so as to make daily tasks difficult.

Before any procedure takes place, we will meet with you for an initial consultation to evaluate your injuries and determine the best stem cell injection options for you."

The stem cell therapies provided at Denver Regenerative Medicine are options for treating the deterioration of the joints of the shoulders, knees, elbows, and hips and for enhancing the healing for soft tissues. This can help the patient in avoiding joint replacement surgery, which involves the amputation of the biological joint and replacement by a synthetic prosthesis. Joint replacement surgery has the disadvantage of being very difficult and painful for the patient and it may even result in negative long term side effects. Joint prostheses have been observed to involve high risks for stroke and heart attacks. Prostheses metals and particulates may also be absorbed into the bloodstream.

Aside from stem cell therapy, Denver Regenerative Medicine offers other kinds of treatments. These include acCELLerate? treatments, REjuvenate? therapy, and hormone replacement therapy. The clinic?s AcCELLerate ? Stem Cell regeneration system involves the use of stem cells and platelet-rich plasma (PRP) to allow growth factors from the PRP to start activating the stem cells immediately. PRP has been observed to enhance the healing capability of stem cell therapies. PRP only needs a few simple preparatory steps and can be done on an outpatient basis.

The REjuvenate? Therapy can be used for men and women and is designed for people who want an overall boost in their vitality and health. It is a combination of hormone replacement therapy and stem cell therapy. Taking advantage of the synergy of the two treatments, this may be used for illnesses resulting from hormonal imbalance that may have been caused by toxins, stress, and other natural factors.

Meanwhile, hormone replacement therapy (HRT) is a treatment option for both men and women who have hormone imbalance problems. For men, symptoms of hormone imbalance include lower muscle mass and increased body fat; less interest in sex; erectile dysfunction; fatigue; loss of facial and body hair; and depression and cognitive issues. For women, symptoms include thinning hair; irregular menstrual cycles; painful or unusually heavy periods; vaginal dryness; weight gain; increased growth of hair on the face, chest, back or neck; and hot flashes.

The medical team at Denver Regenerative Medicine can provide patients with information regarding the differences between HRT for women and HRT for men. They make use of bioidentical hormone replacement therapies to ensure that the hormones they use are chemically identical to the hormones that are actually produced by the body. This may help in getting the best possible results for the patient.
