

MMD Medical Doctors Has Moved to a New Office Location

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MMD Medical Doctors - Medical Marijuana Red Card Evaluations, based in Denver, Colorado, has announced that they have moved to a new office location that is deemed to be more central than the previous one to allow them to provide their help to a broader audience. Their medical marijuana certified doctors in Colorado help patients who need a medical marijuana card. In Colorado, cannabis is a state-legal alternative to prescription pain medication. A licensed medical marijuana doctor in the state is allowed to assess and prescribe medical marijuana to eligible patients.

A manager from MMD Medical Doctors says, "Our certified Medical Marijuana doctors will review your medical history to determine if you qualify for treating your condition with Medical Marijuana and/or prescription pain medications. During your evaluation, we will both assess and identify any of your conditions that can be helped with Medical Marijuana. A discussion on your medical history will also be conducted. Your doctor may request prior medical records in order to make a proper diagnosis and recommendation."

It should be noted that there are qualifying and non-qualifying conditions for medical marijuana in Colorado. Some of the qualifying medical conditions that are eligible for a red card from on the MMD Medical Doctors are: HIV/AIDS, cachexia, cancer, seizures, severe nausea, glaucoma, severe pain, and persistent muscle spasms. On the other hand, these conditions have not been approved to be included in the list of debilitating medical conditions provided for in the Colorado constitution: atherosclerosis, bi-polar disorder, asthma, diabetes mellitus (types 1 and 2), diabetic retinopathy, Chron's disease, hypertension, methicillin-resistant staphylococcus aureus (MRSA), hepatitis C, post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), severe anxiety, opioid dependence, Tourette's syndrome, and clinical depression. Medical marijuana may also be prescribed for pain management. During the evaluation of the patient by the doctor, the source or sources of pain are identified and assessed. In a number of cases, pharmaceutical medication may be used as a safe alternative to surgical intervention. The physicians at MMD Medical

Doctors employ a holistic approach for the treatment of holistic pain, which will provide the patient with peace of mind in the knowledge that the physicians are capable of resolving the root cause of the issue, and not just the symptom. Instead of the usual quick fix for the pain, a long-term solution for the pain will be provided.

It should be noted that medical marijuana is cannabis that has a tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) content larger than 0.03 percent. On the other hand, hemp is cannabis with THC content that is equal to or less than 0.03 percent. THC is the naturally occurring psychoactive compound that is found in cannabis and is responsible for the "high" experienced by patients when using cannabis. Cannabidiol (CBD) is a non-psychoactive compound also found in cannabis that has been found to have therapeutic benefits for patients who use cannabis.

In some states, marijuana has been declared legal only for medicinal purposes. But in Colorado, it has been declared legal for both recreational and medicinal purposes. However, this is strictly regulated by the Colorado Department of Revenue, particularly its Marijuana Enforcement Division. Those who have been granted a Medical Marijuana Registration Card or "red card" will have access to any state-licensed dispensary in order to buy medical marijuana. At present, there are more than 600 dispensaries in Colorado. Those who have opted not to specify a primary caregiver on their medical marijuana application may be allowed to grow their own at home.

Those who want to schedule a marijuana referral appointment can check out the MMD Medical Doctors website, or contact them through the telephone or via email.
