Harig explains that homeowners who invest in green energy equipment are able to make use of Residential Renewable Tax Credit. This allows them to deduct 26% of the cost of installing a renewable energy system from their federal taxes, effectively reducing the financial impact that it has on their finances. The equipment that qualifies for the Residential Renewable Energy Tax Credit includes solar, wind, geothermal and fuel-cell technology, with the only requirement being that they are used in the home. The implementation of such equipment contributes to the preservation of fast depleting energy sources around the world, though homeowners will also see the positive impact that these devices can have on their home. Certain energy-efficient home improvements such as new, double-layered reflective windows can help diminish the impact of temperature changes over the seasons, for instance. As a result, this reduces the need to use an HVAC system to heat or cool the home, extending its lifespan and significantly reducing energy consumption over the summer and winter seasons.

As appealing as all of these benefits may appear at first sight, Bell Harig Home Inspection states that it is most sensible to approach any changes with caution in order to ensure that everything is done according to the regulatory standards provided. Through their post, the company says, "For many different types of home repair and improvement jobs, permits are required. Though simple repairs usually don't call for permits, additions or major changes—particularly those that involve structural work, electrical, heating and plumbing—usually demand that you get the appropriate permits from the local building department."

The company states that building permits are usually handled by the contractor or subcontractor hired for the project, though they advise homeowners to pay close attention to this matter as well. If a contractor suggests that a major remodeling project does not need a building permit, this may be a sign that they are either unreliable, inexperienced or working outside the law. Either way, the most sensible path to take in this situation is to check with the building department.

"Do yourself a favor and don't ignore the legal and safety aspects of any home improvement idea you have. Otherwise, you may have a hard time in the future, particularly if you choose to sell your home," states Harig.
