One of the primary services offered by the professionals at the Norwich office of The Mortgage Bureau is to

help first-time buyers. Under UK law, first-time buyers are given special consideration. They are allowed to save on stamp duty but the problem is that there are some issues with regards to the definition of a first-time buyer. Thus, it would be a good idea to check this with a professional to make sure you are able to benefit from the savings. First-time buyers are excused from paying stamp duty for home purchases up to 300,000 pounds sterling. And they only need to pay a rate of 5 per cent on the portions between 300,001 to 500,000 pounds sterling. However, for homes that have a price of more than 500,000 pounds sterling, regular stamp duty will be required.

Another vital service provided by The Mortgage Bureau is the renegotiation of a mortgage for the purpose of having a more affordable interest rate through a different service provider, known as remortgaging. This is possible with The Mortgage Bureau because they have access to the whole marketplace. The remortgage process will mean paying off what is owed on the current mortgage by using the proceeds from a new mortgage with the same property offered as security. The primary goal is to have a reduced interest rate that, in turn, will greatly decrease the monthly payments or enable earlier repayment.

Another important service available from The Mortgage Bureau is for buy to let landlords who want to boost their property portfolio. Landlords are not permitted to make use of the ordinary mortgages that are available for residential home buyers. It is therefore essential for them to ask for the assistance of a professional who has in-depth knowledge on buy-to-let property financing terms.
