Prior to calling upon professional help, however, homeowners can take a few simple and safe steps to determine for themselves whether their roof endured the last storm unscathed. If they can reach their attic, for instance, they should examine the interior of the roof for any obvious holes. This process is likely to be much easier during the day as sunlight would illuminate any big holes or gaps in the decking. Similarly, a flashlight can be used to check for evidence of damage caused by moisture, such as dark stains, streaks or sagging.

Outside, the roof's shingles should be checked for signs of wear and tear. For instance, homeowners may notice that some shingles are cracked or curled, especially if the recent storm had high winds and caused debris to strike the roof. Similarly, any missing shingles should be identified and replaced as soon as possible. Furthermore, the company advises that any debris still left over on the roof should be cleared off immediately. Fallen tree branches and other objects, for instance, can rub the granules loose from a roof's shingles over time, and they may even hide more extensive damage such as cracks and holes beneath.

Should such damage be noticed, homeowners are advised to seek professional help as soon as possible. Roofs can be surprisingly difficult to fix, especially if the party attempting the repair is unfamiliar with the appropriate safety measures that should be taken during the process.
