Mario Lemeaux from Furnace Repair Oshawa says, "In spite of the fact that it's a lot more budget-friendly to replace a furnace before it dies, many homeowners are reluctant to shell out the dollars for a new furnace before they know for sure that their heating system absolutely can no longer do its job. But that reluctance could cost you a lot more than you think when your old furnace goes in the dead of the winter and destroys the drywall, pipes, or even the carpet in your home."

One indication that the furnace may already be need to be replaced is an unusual rise in the home's energy expenses. If the energy bill has been rising and this can't be adequately explained by an extremely cold outside temperature, it may be because the furnace is no longer capable of providing the amount of warmth that it used to. Homeowners may be able to find out if there are other possible reasons for the rise in energy costs by checking the filter or other similar issues but if everything else checks out, then there is really a need for the furnace to be replaced.

According to the article on the "8 signs you need a new furnace," another indication is when repairs for the furnace have become more frequent. While it is possible to continue having the furnace repaired and buying new parts, the reality is that furnace replacement is inevitable and the homeowner is merely postponing it. Meanwhile, such repairs may add up to a significant amount of expenses that may have been put to better use in paying for a new furnace.

A third sign that the furnace for the home may already need to be replaced is inconsistency of the

temperatures from one room to another, especially if the furnace used to equally distribute warmth to all rooms. It is important to note, however, that the design and construction of a room may also affect the inside temperature. Thus, it is advisable to consult a furnace expert to find out what is really causing the heating inconsistencies.

Also, when the furnace regularly cycles on and off, it may be an indication of a system failure. Or it may be a sign that there are some leaks or an open window. Once again, it would be a good idea to consult with an HVAC expert.

Another sign that the heating system may already need to be replaced is humidity problems in the home. If the humidity feels like it is higher than usual, then it would be a good idea to investigate. Humidity usually comes from the intake air for the furnace. At the very least, it may mean that there is a need to replace the intake or exhaust.

And then there is the situation where there is an unusual level of noise coming from the furnace. This could be caused by the clanking of a worn-out electric motor or the expansion and contraction of the pipes. It may be a good idea to call on the local HVAC professional if the furnace has become too noisy. Other indications include the spurting out of dust and soot from the outlets, and too much rusting around the heating system.
