?Reduce range of motion during healing. If you are healing from an injury, it is important to limit motion on the lower back to make sure that you give the injury ample time to heal. The brace will reduce twisting, backwards, forward, and side movements. Limiting painful motion will also help in establishing proper positions of the body and allow you to adjust the posture for better back health.

?Reduce inter-vertebral segments micro-motion. Braces can also limit the small movements that exist between particular spinal segments or even vertebral fracture. This will in turn limit the pain that emanates from muscle tension and irritated nerve roots or joints. A back brace added to a treatment plan has indicated mobility improvement and improvement of sores better than pain medication and therapy. There is, however, more research needed to confirm this.?
