AA meetings, for instance, will now have to take place over digital platforms, which are likely to be unfamiliar (and therefore uncomfortable) environments in and of themselves. While access to this sort of help can mitigate the sense of exclusion brought about by social distancing, it may not be enough for some.

Many will also have no other choice than to work extra hard on maintaining their sobriety by themselves, and Rehab Near Me encourages these individuals to seek out whatever healthy means they can find to support themselves and their sobriety.
