Finn states that using manual effort and cleaning solutions are a great first step in disinfecting a surface, but it is impossible to clean every square inch of surface areas in a commercial building the traditional way. Due to this reason, bacteria and viruses can still spread in parts and crevices that were not reached by the cleaning agent, such as keyboards, desks, telephones and other gadgets.

As a solution, St. Louis Cleaning and Restoration, uses disinfectant that is registered with the EPA and is proven to kill the deadly coronavirus. Application of the disinfectant is done with a ULV (Ultra Low Volume) Fogger or electrostatic sprayer. When done quickly and evenly, these methods treat surfaces much better than traditional cleaning methods. The electrostatic sprayers work by charging liquids such as sanitizers and disinfectants as they get released. As the disinfecting solution exits the nozzle, the electrostatic sprayer gives a negative charge to it. The charged molecules will then repel one another and actively be attracted to the surface they are applied to. The result is a uniform coating of sanitizer or disinfectant on sprayed objects, including hard-to-reach areas that manual cleaning can miss.

St. Louis Cleaning and Restoration utilizes the latest electrostatic spray technology due to its effectiveness as well as the fact that it provides a broader approach to disinfecting an entire room or office? and does so more efficiently. Harmful bacteria and viruses, if not eliminated properly through the right methods, can live on surfaces for days. This provides an opportunity for cross-contamination to take place, which should be avoided at all costs.

?During the cleaning process, your building must be evacuated of all individuals. They can return to work one hour after treatment. Our technicians will be protected by wearing the proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) consistent with the severity of the situation and the disinfectant we would be applying,? Finn explains.
