Roofing for traditional residential properties is usually quite straightforward and the number of options available is limited in comparison to commercial roofing. Not everyone is aware of the important differences between the two. Understanding those differences and the choices that need to be made for commercial premises or properties and how best to make those choices is what Cox Roofing wants business owners to understand.

Firstly, property owners need to be aware that there are several different kinds of roofing to choose from. One of the least expensive options when it comes to commercial roofing is called built-up roofing (BUR). This is a very popular choice for many small business owners because it is probably the cheapest option that will still perform its function satisfactorily. BUR is made from tar and gravel which are stacked together. It is usually one of the most affordable options with prices that start at as little as \$4 per square foot. BUR offers superior strength and may well last for around 20 to 25 years. However, according to experts, if installed correctly and coupled with the right maintenance, BUR can have its lifespan extended by 10 to 15 years. A 40-year lifespan

is obviously desirable but is dependent on maintenance.

BUR is not the only choice and there are other options available but they are usually more expensive. These options involve metal roofing of which there are several different kinds. The lifespan of a metal roof is much longer than the standard BUR type when the requisite maintenance is not carried out. Metal roofs can last as long as 50 years and some can do so without the maintenance required by BUR. This additional lifespan does come at an additional cost. The cost per square foot is about \$12 for steel roofing but aluminum roofing can skew the price much higher and can even go as high as \$100 per square foot.
