Walla went on to state that many of the safety practices they put in place at the beginning of the virus will still apply to their interior painting jobs. Both customers and employees must maintain proper social distancing during an interior painting project and his crews will practice strict hygiene measures such as removing shoes before entering a home and constantly washing their hands during the process. They will also be collecting payment remotely and Walla says it's in everyone's best interest to still conduct consultations by phone or video conferencing.

The company owner also emphasized that at no time during an interior painting project will their high-quality standards be compromised. They will still be taking such steps as removing furniture from interior rooms that need to be painted and they will cover and mask objects in a room that are not practical to remove. He also mentioned that all of their experienced painting crew leaders have been retained so all their interior painting jobs will go along smoothly just like they have in the past. Walla also stated that they never consider any type of interior painting work to be finished until a thorough cleanup has been done and the area has been inspected to make sure any stray paint droplets have been removed.

For those who have been requesting cabinet painting from them, Walla confirmed that this is part of the interior painting services that the company will resume. He wanted to thank those who have been patiently waiting to get this service done. This type of service has been in high demand because it's much less expensive than doing kitchen cabinet replacement but yields similar results thanks to the company's many years of doing this type of interior painting work.

Walla says that other parts of the business still function under what they term the "new normal". He says that they are out every day doing inspections and preparing estimates for those interested in their services. At the current time, the company has several outside painting projects already ongoing.
