In the Reviewimo Snowmobile GPS article, the company explores the basics of a GPS system and the crucial role it plays in outdoor adventures and activities. GPS is an abbreviation for Global Positioning System, and its navigational ability is enabled by satellites that send information of the geolocation on a map as well as the approximate time required to reach a destination back to the device. With the advancement of technology as well as the ongoing research done by scientists, GPSs have become more advanced and have further

minimized, if not eliminated, the risks of their users ever getting lost.

Meanwhile, the article also highlights the difference between driving on asphalt and driving in snow. Driving in snow means one has to drive in high altitude areas, snow-capped mountains and even frozen bodies of water. Due to this difference, the attributes required for a GPS for snow-riding are also unique and more complex than a GPS intended for normal use. For example, the GPS one uses for snow-riding must be able to work in low temperatures. Some handheld GPS devices are able to do this, but not all. This would normally make finding the most optimal GPS for one's snowmobile a hard task. However, Reviewimo has made this search much easier by listing down the best GPSs for snowmobiles that are currently on the market.

In fifth place of their list is the Garmin Etrex 20X, an upgraded version of its predecessor, the eTrex 20. This model is affordable yet very functional and impressive for its price. As noted in the article, the device comes with a 2.2" color display with a resolution of 240 x 320 pixels. Another impressive feature of the device is its highly sensitive tracking system, which boasts an upgraded WAAS-enabled GPS receiver.

On the fourth spot is the Garmin Etrex 30X Handheld GPS Navigator. This model also has a 2.2" display with a resolution of 240 x 320 pixels. However, it has a better screen since it utilizes a 65k color display. The device has an internal memory of 3.7 GB and comes with a barometric altimeter that helps the user keep track of the changes in pressure that occur with a shift in altitude. This model can survive high altitudes and low temperatures and also has an electronic compass with 3-axis tilt-compensation.

The Trail Tech 912-502 Voyager Stealth Black Moto-GPS Computer, an impressive product at an unbelievably low price, comes in third place. The device has a 240 x 400 WQVGA LCD display with backlight that helps the user read the information at night. The model is crash-resistant and can accept both AC or DC power. It is also compatible with all kinds of 4-wheel drives.

In second place is the Garmin Montana 680T. This model is said to have many impressive features, one of which is the device's 4" wide color display screen, which is dual-oriented. Another striking feature is its high resolution 8 megapixel autofocus camera. The device is also easy to mount and is glove-friendly. Notably, it comes with a free one-year subscription for BirdsEye Satellite Imagery.

Given a full 5-Star rating by Reviewimo, the Trail Tech 912-2035 Voyager Stealth Black Moto-GPS is named the best GPS for snowmobiles in the article. This device has an excellent quality and high resolution 240 x 400 WQVGA LCD screen. This feature enables the user to see and read the displayed information easily. The display is also backlit, which means the user can view and operate the device even in the dark. Additionally, the device's display shows information on the speed, ambient temperature of the surroundings and of the engine, distance, wheel sensor and even the altitude. The user can also see the map, stopwatch and a compass on the device's screen.
