Judging by the severity of the situation, it could have seriously affected the integrity of the entire property if it had been left unattended any longer.?

Despite the extent of the water damage, Olsen clarifies that a relatively fast response on their client's part allowed the company to address the issue before any signs of mold began to appear, which would have made the project much more complicated to deal with. Signs of water damage were present on kitchen cabinets, walls and cork floors, all of which were beyond saving and needed replacing. Adjacent rooms were also affected by the leak?the company states that they found minor water damage in a closet in the adjacent room as well as the house's basement.

?Our client did a great job of identifying the leak and contacting us before the situation got even worse,? states Olsen. However, there was one more minor setback before the company could carry on the restoration. He explains, ?The job was delayed for a few days because the access to a damaged wall was restricted due to a fish tank that needed to be partially drained and moved. We tried to make the most out of the situation while this setback was taken care of, and we did quick work of the restoration project once it had been solved. The total cost of the project, restoration and repairs came out to \$12,000. This is one of the best examples of when prevention is better than a cure since the situation could have spun out of control over the course of the next few months if it had gone on unnoticed."
