Enfamil states that some parents may see benefits in this formula's use by their babies in as little as 48-hours after the first feeding. Symptoms of colic include crying or fussing for more than 3 hours a day, crying repeatedly for no obvious reason (they have been fed and have no dirty diaper), they cry at the same time each day, or they tend to clench their fists or curl their legs while crying. This is a condition that can severely increase a new mother's stress level and needs to be addressed as soon as possible. The company spokesperson also acknowledged that babies with formula allergies show some specific signs too. These include frequent spitting up, vomiting, excessive crying, frequent diarrhea, possible blood in the stool, and hives.

According to the company spokesperson, it's not enough that a customer's baby is showing signs of colic or food allergies to be eligible to have all or part of the child's Nutramigen formula requirements covered by insurance. These conditions must first be confirmed by a dedicated health professional and a prescription must be written for it.
