TPO is the abbreviated version of this material's real name which is 'Thermoplastic Polyolefin'. Many people also refer to it as a rubber roof because it consists primarily of a synthetic rubber compound.

The article went on to say that it goes down over any flat or low slope roof in the form of a single-ply synthetic membrane. TPO roof systems are also sometimes referred to as 'white roofs' because the exterior side of the membrane has a white reflective coating on it. The post mentioned that there are other color choices too such as black and beige which work well for commercial flat roofs in the cooler Greater Toronto area.

In the article, it went on to state that some of the main reasons that a company would choose a TPO roof are its energy-saving features and the fact that it can be affordably installed.

It was also noted in the article that TPO roofing systems can be made to blend in with the color of their surroundings so they look good. It's also a very durable and long-lasting roof system and this longevity makes it a very cost-effective flat roof covering. Flat roofs that are covered in TPO material also handle expansion and contraction due to changing temperatures very well.

Some of the drawbacks that were mentioned in the TPO blog post included this roof system's higher initial cost and the fact that the seam adhesives used to put sections together will degrade faster than the roof material itself; this necessitates periodic inspections and repairs of the seams to prevent leaking.
