Stacey Brisman wants to stress that there are three primary advantages offered by online dermatology consultations. First is effectiveness. Teledermatology services can allow doctors to offer effective care that might be possible for certain patients because of travel restrictions, geographic distance, or concerns regarding social distancing. Studies have demonstrated that online dermatology is an appropriate and an efficient way to serve patients who might otherwise not be able to receive care.
