"The extent of your injuries can only be determined by a qualified professional, and you certainly should not postpone your visit because your pain is not too severe at the moment," says Dr. Keating. "You may not know what is causing your back pain or how severe it is, which could lead to experiencing the pain for months or years after your car accident. It's not easy to know if your back pain is a muscle strain, a soft tissue injury, or something more serious. Each of these carries its own risks, and the only way to know for sure is to be evaluated by a medical professional like a chiropractor."

Aside from the obvious back pain, the clinic states that there are other symptoms that indicate a severe back injury. These include numbness, tingling, weakness and loss of bladder or bowel control. If any of these symptoms are present, the patient should avoid exercise and rough movements until they receive medical attention. This is to avoid worsening their condition.
