He also added that for those that prefer to go cold water walleye fishing they should not be discouraged either. That's because they have fishing methods that have still proven to be successful under cooler water conditions too. Wyatt says that their walleye fishing trips are done mainly on the Snake and Columbia Rivers and originate in such cities as Lewiston ID, Clarkston WA, Lyons Ferry WA, Richland WA, Pasco WA, Kennewick WA, Umatilla OR, or Biggs Junction OR.
