One such method by which the company helped their community was assisting in the restoration of cast-iron pipes. Pipes made from this material are known to last between 80-100 years but they do fail eventually, and residents are more likely to experience issues with failing pipes if the property in question was built a long time ago. To address the situation, Armstrong Bros Plumbing has been utilizing a method of trenchless pipe rehabilitation known as pipelining to repair existing pipelines. This negates the need for other, more invasive methods of pipe replacement that may ultimately be too expensive or disruptive for the residents in question.

DeLauder explains that the company uses a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) for this process, which forms a jointless and seamless internal pipe within the previous pipe. It can be used to rehabilitate pipes between 0.1 to 2.8 meters (2-110 inches) and is one of the most commonly used methods of pipe rehabilitation around the world. By the end of the process, any gaps (such as those caused by pipe erosion or structural damage) in the original piping are covered by the CIPP, eliminating any leaks that previously plagued the property. CIPP also boasts a high resistance to oils, chemicals, high temperatures and more, making it an ideal solution for an extremely wide array of circumstances.

Armstrong Bros Plumbing's ability to respond both promptly and effectively to their customers with such non-destructive solutions has made them a favorite in the area for many years.
