Their most popular service is robotic spine surgery, which is effective in treating chronic back pain. While there is a risk of further complications due to the usage of screw placements, this technique is proven to be more precise than traditional methods. Furthermore, no X-rays are used to check the condition of the spine; as a result, cancer and the other harmful side effects of radiation can be avoided. Other innovative methods of surgery that the clinic offers include the following: anterior cervical discectomy and fusion, minimally invasive lumbar discectomy and laser spine surgery.

The clinic also offers physical therapy to their clients. This kind of treatment aims to reduce body strain through a regimen of massage, hot and cold water and regular exercise. It is proven to not just help people restore their mobility (i.e. walking and standing) but also relieve pain caused by muscular injuries. Moreover, it is a safer alternative to pain-killing drugs, injections, traditional surgeries and other invasive methods of treatment. The clinic also has a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) machine, wherein electromagnetic waves are used to display 3D images of the skeletal and nervous systems, among others. In this process, magnetic fields induce signals in the water molecules present in patients? bodies to produce cross-sectional images. MRI?s are known to boast higher resolution imaging and are safer than X-rays.
