Meanwhile, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has revealed that the economic impact of opioid abuse in the US has already reached up to \$78 billion per year. On top of that are the serious health issues faced by people who are misusing opioids and the children who lose one or both parents as a result. The NIDA statistics include the cost of being treated for addiction, healthcare costs, involvement of criminal justice, and the loss in productivity.

Nevertheless, it is essential for people who are struggling with a drug addiction, including their loved ones, to know that there is hope.
