One of the newest, most effective breakthroughs in spinal surgery is robotic spine surgery, which makes spinal surgery more precise and, therefore, less invasive and safer. The team at Progressive Spine and Orthopaedics, led by Dr. Rovner, are capable to providing treatment for various spinal conditions. These include general back pain, adolescent idiopathic scoliosis, adult degenerative scoliosis, kyphosis, ankylosing spondylitis, myelopathy, neck pain, sciatic nerve pain, rheumatoid arthritis, spondylosis, sacroiliac joint syndrome, spondylolisthesis, lumbar stenosis, spinal tumors, spinal conditions in children, cervical disc herniation, lumbar disc herniation, and spinal fractures. With regards to spinal surgery, they offer robotic spine surgery, anterior cervical discectomy, cervical disc replacement, lumbar spinal fusion, minimally invasive lumbar discectomy, laser spine surgery, and revision spine surgery.

Robotic spinal surgery makes use of the Mazor Renaissance Robot, which has gained a reputation for its precision and safety when used for neurosurgery in general, and for spinal surgery in particular. The difficulty in conventional spinal surgery is that the surgeon has to determine the appropriate position for the screws through the help of x-rays that were taken before the surgery. Unfortunately, x-rays are unable to provide a complete picture and there is a substantial risk for the improper placement of the screws and even a minor error can result into pain, decreased mobility, and even paralysis.

Robotic spinal surgery removes the uncertainty with regards to the proper placement of the screws with an accuracy of 1mm. This accuracy can minimize the pain and recovery time, and decreases the risk of post-operative complications.

They also provide physical therapy and pain management. Physical therapy, which is typically known for promoting movement and restoring function, is also a very effective modality for treating chronic pain, especially the kind of pain that is due to the spine. As such, physical therapists will usually offer the first clinical treatment for neck and back pain. This is because studies have shown that physical therapy can offer much greater relief for pain resulting from musculoskeletal conditions compared to opioid medication, and that the longer it is applied, the more effective it will be.
