These include Botox, Kybella, various fillers, platelet-rich plasma (PRP), and more. These non-surgical facial treatment options allow them to treat a wide range of skin conditions, such as fine lines, wrinkles, contour deformities, and volume loss. These treatments allow them to help people feel and look their best with the least hassle and downtime.

Botox is the only approved prescription treatment for temporarily enhancing the appearance of moderate to

severe "crow's feet" and frown lines between the eyebrows. These lines develop over time because of the repeated movements of the skin between the eyebrows and muscles around the eyes. With a small injection of Botox into the targeted muscles, the movement of the muscles that cause these lines to appear is decreased, with the result that the appearance of the facial skin is enhanced. A few days after the Botox injection, a visible smoothing of the frown lines and crow's feet will be observed between the eyebrows. These will continue to be observed for about four months. Meanwhile, non-surgical injections of Kybella may be used to address the "double chin." The FDA has approved the use of Kybella for the neck but it has also been observed to be useful for under-arm/ bra fat. The active ingredient of Kybella is deoxycholic acid, which is a chemical that naturally occurs in the body and has been found to help in the breakdown and absorption of fat. The dissolved fat is then excreted by the intestines and the kidneys. Kybella treatment requires the injection of deoxycholic acid under the skin where excess fat is located. There will be usually two to four injection sites with a cannula used to apply the injection. The total number of treatments will vary from two to six treatments and they are spaced six weeks apart.

With regards to fillers, some of the products offered at Lift Plastic Surgery are Voluma, Vollure, Restylane, Volbella and Juvederm. Restylane is a hyaluronic acid and is applied for various targeted treatments for facial tissue. The Defyne and Refyne products are for mid-to-deep injections for treating facial folds and wrinkles, such as "smile lines." These products are designed to function like the body's own naturally occurring hyaluronic acid to add restorative volume to the shape of the patient's facial expressions. Meanwhile, Volbella XC and Restylane Silk are designed to soften and fill the fine lines around the lips and mouth.

Juvederm is also a hyaluronic acid and has various products that enable the treatment provider to customize a patient's treatment plan. Juvederm and Juvederm Ultra are for treating moderate to severe facial folds and wrinkles. By adding volume, not only is the patient's youthful appearance maintained, but it also makes the skin look soft and natural. Voluma XC is for lifting and contouring the cheeks. This is because as people age, they not only lose fat and collagen, but the overall tissue volume of their face as well.

And finally, PRP is obtained from the patient's own blood to help in skin rejuvenation. It may be injected alone as a way to help stimulate the formation of collagen and fill in small amounts of volume that is lacking on the skin.
