This is because they cannot add additional bottles at the present time because they would run out of bottles. Customers can call the office to confirm the availability of all spring water products.

They offer water delivery service to a wide range of customers, such as municipalities, vendors, athletic clubs, businesses, hospitals, schools, residential homes, and more. The ordering system has been made simple. First, customers will call them when they need a delivery. A service representative will be receiving the customer calls and will jot down the delivery order, and then remind the customer of the delivery day. Customers would want to take note of the delivery schedule that they have posted on their website for different areas in New Jersey.

They would also like to remind customers that the Diamond Rock Spring Water bottles and water coolers have to be cleaned or sanitized periodically. It is possible for the bottled water to last for long periods of time while maintaining the quality and taste of the water. However, customers are reminded to rotate the bottles by utilizing the oldest bottles first. Furthermore, it is very important to make sure that the bottles are not stored in a place where they can get exposed to direct sunlight. Direct sunlight can promote the growth of algae over time, thus affecting the quality of the bottled water.

They also would like to remind customers that if their cooler leaks, it is 99 percent likely that it is caused by a defective bottle. The bottle may have a pin hole or tiny fracture. This often occurs in older bottles that have undergone several cycles of cleaning and sanitizing. They suggest a procedure for testing a water bottle to find out if there is a leak.

Diamond Rock Spring Water is also a direct distributor of all Keurig K-Cups and Brewers. They offer at least 140 brands of K-Cups, including a range of coffee and tea.
