



Newport Beach Breast Augmentation Surgeon Always Works Closely with Patients

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Aaron Kosins MD, a breast augmentation surgeon in Newport Beach, CA, has revealed that he always works closely with his patients to make sure that he fully understands what each specific patient believes is a beautiful breast. He believes that while surgery and techniques can be learned during surgical training, there is no similar training on the concept of what makes a beautiful breast. Each woman has her own belief on what is a beautiful breast, which is why he works closely with them to ensure that the results will be considered satisfactory by each particular patient.

Aaron Kosins MD explains, "My philosophy is to listen very carefully to the wishes of my patients. My patients and I are a team. By being open and listening to each other, we can make decisions about what procedure is right for you. I follow my patients and their surgical results indefinitely, and the relationship lasts our lifetime. My goal is to be your doctor for all your aesthetic needs. Importantly, my staff and I will provide all the information you need to make an intelligent and informed decision."

He wants to point out that his primary goal is to understand the patient's preferences in terms of the size of the breast desired, the location of the incision, and the overall appearance of the breast, including upper pole

fullness, cleavage, and nipple location. To achieve the patient's desired appearance of her breasts, Aaron Kosins MD uses advanced breast, such as the Natrelle® breast implants. These implants have recently been made available to US plastic surgeons and they provide the advantage of being available in a broad range of sizes and projections that will ensure that the breasts will have the desired look while offering a soft feel.

The Newport Beach breast augmentation procedure is used to enlarge the size of the breasts and is currently one of the most popular cosmetic surgery procedures in the United States. This is performed using saline or silicone implants that are usually positioned below the muscle of the chest wall. This implant will increase the breast size but it will have minimal impact on the shape of the breast or the nipple-areola position.

Several important decisions will need to be made for a patient's primary breast augmentation, particularly because it will affect the patient's breasts for the remainder of her life. The goal of Dr. Kosins is optimal breast size and shape while also balancing what the tissues will allow him to do. Of key importance is the maximum implant coverage with breast tissue, including an in-depth discussion of how the implant will affect the overlying breast tissue. The size and shapes of implants that can be placed would depend on the quality of the breast envelope and tissue. If the size and shape of the implants go beyond capacity, it could leave the patient "breast handicapped" for life.

Meanwhile, the location of the incision can be below the breast, around the areola, or in the armpit. Dr. Kosins doesn't use the belly button approach because it offers the least control of the breast pocket. Each of the three incision locations has its own advantages and disadvantages, and he can discuss these with the patient during consultation. In general, pocket control is the most important factor. The incision location should permit optimal sterility and meticulous dissection to ensure that the patient would be able to go back to regular social activities the day after the surgery.

The final key decision is whether to use silicone or saline implants. It should be noted that studies have not revealed any increase in the risks of certain diseases, including cancer, due to breast implants. The breast augmentation procedure is an outpatient procedure and is typically performed under general anesthesia.
