The third podcast, Express Entry ? Language Testing, explains the minimum language score acceptable to be granted permanent resident status under Express Entry. It also provides resources that users can check to determine if their language score is sufficient to be accepted.

Holthe observes, "The internet is full of people offering information, and asking that people pay for that information. It is virtually impossible for an individual to determine which representative is best suited to help them."

The podcasts are designed to answer questions and help individuals to determine whether or not they qualify for Express Entry, as well as offer them resources to help them become qualified.
