NSR of Asheville, takes a holistic approach to addiction, equipping men with the skills they need to achieve long term addiction recovery. NSR of Asheville bridges the gap between inpatient detox and long-term self-sufficiency. They use methods like CBT, DBT, adventure therapy, yoga, meditation, and martial arts to help their patients break out of their patterns and gain perspective for long-term recovery. They take a step beyond the 30, 60, or 90-day program. According to them, detox is only the first step after which the real work begins. The program aims to create a sense of camaraderie between the men they treat. In the short-term, this creates a crucial support network that everyone recovering from addiction can benefit from and it creates lasting friendships that sustain lasting sobriety.

Susan Stader, a spokesperson for NSR of Asheville says, "The trail up the mountain from addiction to contributing members of society is full of thorns and pitfalls. Yours may even have creatures of self-contempt lying in wait for you along the way. You're going to have to fight through all of it. A life of self-sufficiency is the ultimate goal. Our transitional living program supports young men in the attainment of that goal. As we say, recovery is an adventure. We encourage young men who are suffering from addiction to take the journey with us. You can lean on NSR of Asheville as your support network while you work towards sustainable sobriety. You don't have to make the climb back to a life of meaning by yourself, but you do have to start. We help you by nudging you in the correct direction."

The program's facilities are chosen to open, well-lit houses with inviting shared spaces. This includes well-furnished kitchens, spacious living rooms, and outdoor sitting areas. These facilities help set the stage for healthy living habits post-recovery.
