It is currently the biggest fully fellowship trained private pain practice in Illinois and they have clinics in Chicago, Downers Grove, Schaumburg, and Berwyn.

They offer treatment for various kinds of pain. These include: abdominal pain, adhesiolysis, auto accident injuries, back pain, cancer pain, carpal tunnel syndrome, chest pain, chronic post-operative pain, complex regional pain syndrome, degenerative disc disease, facet syndrome and arthritis, facial pain, foot pain, head pain, knee pain, neck pain, neuroma, osteoarthritis, pelvic pain, piriformis syndrome, plantar fasciitis, post stroke pain, sciatica, shoulder pain, spine pain, tailbone pain, and trigeminal neuralgia.

Aside from interventional pain management treatments, they also offer other services, such as biologic regenerative therapy, platelet rich plasma, and ketamine infusion therapy. For all of these kinds of services, they are ready to provide telehealth services to provide consultation for both new and existing patients.

The interventional pain medicine services that they provide uses a balanced approach that combines various modalities of therapies designed to reduce pain. Their pain management experts offer a comprehensive range of solutions for patients with various conditions, from diagnosis to treatment and rehabilitation.

Meanwhile, biologic regenerative therapy is also provided and offers various advantages. These include the

fact that it is safe, nonsurgical and outpatient; patients are able to return to work and recreation; and there are no medication side effects. One example is stem cell therapy in which stem cells are gathered from one of the body's tissues, such as the bone marrow. These are concentrated and then injected into affected body structures. The stem cells are capable of signaling growth factors and other mediators of healing to help in the regeneration of damaged and degenerated tissues at the injection site.

Platelet-rich plasma (PRP) injections in another safe and non-invasive procedure that is often used for tissue injuries, ligament strains, tendon injuries, and joint conditions. In PRP therapy, blood is drawn from people. After centrifuging/ spinning the blood, the platelet-rich plasma is then injected into the joints, ligaments, tissues, and tendons. PRP therapy works because the platelets contain cytokines, which are bioactive healing proteins. These cytokines will attract the assistance of stem cells and initiate repair in the injection site.

They also offer various kinds of pain treatment. These include epidural adhesiolysis, auto accident injury treatment, botox injections in pain management, brachial plexus block, caudal steroid injection, celiac plexus block, chemical neurolysis, epidural blood patch, epidural steroid injections, facet joint injections, ganglion impar block, ilioinguinal and genitofemoral nerve block, intercostal nerve block, interscalene block, intrathecal pain pump, joint injections, ketamine infusion therapy, knee injections, kyphoplasty and vertebroplasty, lumbar discogram, lumbar sympathetic block, medial branch block, nucleoplasty, occipital nerve block, pain medication management, paravertebral nerve block, pars defect injection, percutaneous discectomy, peripheral nerve block, peripheral nerve stimulation, radiofrequency ablation, sacroiliac joint injection, scapulothoracic bursa injection, selective nerve root block, sphenopalatine ganglion block, spinal cord stimulator implant, stellate ganglion block, superior hypogastric plexus block, trigeminal nerve block, trigger point injections, and tunneled epidural catheter.
