It is fitted with a number of new features that allow the waste matter to be isolated from the pump during maintenance work. Additionally, it is made out of solid materials that are built to last, even in marine environments. Innovative materials allow the pump to run up to 3 times longer in dry run conditions than the competition. A Smart Macerator Control (SMC) add on will automatically shut the pump down in dry run condition as well as jog the impeller every 7 days to prevent it from freezing in the pump.

People in the industry have already expressed excitement at the new Raritan Engineering products. "I can't wait to see whether the Fresh Head and the macerator pump are as good as what they say they are," says one eager visitor. "If they actually work the way they are supposed to, I will be installing them on my vessel immediately.
