By type, it is classified as teeth whitening, veneers, implants, crowns, shaping, and bonding. By application, it is classified as redress or beauty.

He received his Australian Dental Certification from the University of Sydney in 2006. Dr. Sirisha has over 15 years of experience. In the days before cosmetic dentistry technology like CEREC, patients would need to wait for weeks to have their dental crowns placed. The process involved two separate appointments. In the first appointment, the dentist would shape the patient?s tooth down and take an impression, which would then be sent to a lab for a dental crown to be created. The patient would then be fitted for a temporary dental crown while they waited, possibly for weeks, until their second visit, where their temporary crown would be removed and the final dental crown would be bonded to the remnants of the natural tooth. Thanks to CEREC, patients can have their dental crown placed in only one appointment. Due to CEREC, there is no more waiting around with a temporary (and more fragile) crown, or coming in for more than one visit.

When asked about the key points of their service, Dr. Shirisha says, ?If you are looking for a dentist in Woden, you will never feel rushed at our practice. We are family-owned and family-focused. We do our best to make our patients feel at home. We use high-end dental equipment that provides the best treatment at the lowest cost for our patients.
