This is on top of the fact that SPF-based roofs do not require much time to install. Metal roof tear-offs require more labour and time to remove, especially when considering rust, debris, and the weight of the roofs. All of these factors mean more labor time before the actual roofing even begins along with additional labor costs.

But that's not all. The Cox Roofing Systems blog post also lists a number of special advantages that SPF has. Spray polyurethane foam is a groundbreaking construction product that has two variations. One is open-cell foams that allow properties to receive exceptional insulation by filling in the gaps with enough force to ensure a tight fit on any space that outside air can penetrate. The second variety is what is mostly used by roofers, closed-cell foams that create a hardened surface on a roof. This surface can withstand hail storms and other harsh weather without much issue.

Further, according to the company, SPF also boasts improved energy efficiency. Both closed-cell and open-cell SPF guarantee improved energy efficiency because they create an airtight seal across the entire property. Once the material cures and dries, it will deliver its advantages swiftly and successfully in most projects, unlike single-ply materials that require adhesives or torching to create seals.
