prevent a freeze. If there is warm air circulating the area around the pipes, the water inside is less likely to get

too cold. Two ways to accomplish this include opening the cabinet below the sink and positioning a fan close

by. It is likewise crucial to make sure that exposed pipes are geared up with the necessary insulation and to

disconnect outside hoses and water spigots to drain the sprinkler system prior to winter?s arrival.
