Jerry Fisher, owner of PureOne Services St. Louis, says, "Sanitizing and disinfecting the physical environment to rid it of the Coronavirus isn't a simple cleaning task. It requires professional knowledge, training, and equipment to do it right. At PureOne Services St. Louis, we follow a 3-step process for thorough and effective disinfecting of your facility."

The first step is to disinfect high-touch-point surfaces. These surfaces are wiped clean by professional

cleaners to ensure that the EPA-suggested disinfectant can work appropriately to kill the viruses. High-touch-point surfaces include light switches, keyboards, doorknobs, desks, vending machines, phones, and other commonly used areas and items.

The second step is the use of a commercial electrostatic spray for applying EPA-recommended disinfectants. By using an electrostatic spray, it can be assured that the disinfectant can reach those crevices that cannot ordinarily be reached by hand. Furthermore, with this technology, the disinfectant is electrostatically charged, which ensures that it will stick to surfaces and coat them on all sides, thus providing a full coating of disinfectant for all items in the sprayed areas. The electrostatic spray will also atomize any respiratory droplets in the air, which means that even the indoor air environment is sanitized.

In the third step, they use an ultra-low volume (ULV) fogger to provide a disinfecting fog in the environment as an extra precaution to make sure that all areas are sanitized. Clients need not worry that the disinfectants used will harm employees, visitors, and other people in the workplace, including animals. Just as a precaution, they will request that people vacate the building first before performing the disinfection process. But employees can get back to work one hour after the treatment.

All of the PureOne Services St. Louis technicians will be wearing proper personal protective equipment (PPE) that comply with stringent health and safety protocols, when necessary. All of their disinfecting and cleaning solutions have been tested safe and have been approved by the EPA. Their cleaning procedures also comply with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards.
