They also provide statistics involving genital herpes, "According to the CDC, there are 776,000 new HSV-2 infections every year in the United States. However, statistics don't show how many of these cases are oral or genital herpes. When genital herpes symptoms appear, they do so after 2 to 12 days of initial exposure. The symptoms appear as blisters on the genitals or the rectum area. You can contract genital herpes from

bodily fluids which include blister or sore fluids, herpes lesions fluid, saliva, vaginal fluid, and semen. This means that genital herpes can be transmitted through unprotected oral sex, vaginal sex, and anal sex. The problem is that condoms will not protect you from herpes since they will not cover all the parts that might be affected by the virus.?
