This treatment is done by injecting a patient with the combination of an anesthetic and a long-lasting steroid. The blog article noticed that each patient responds to the treatment differently but it can be effective for several months. In the new blog post, it also stated that this is a treatment that can be repeated several times if necessary. One very significant benefit that a patient may get from using nerve block therapy if it works, is that it can help delay or altogether avoid invasive surgery. The blog mentioned that this possibility alone is a great incentive for those suffering from chronic pain to give nerve block therapy a try.
