During the course, students will acquire essential knowledge and foundation skills necessary to work in early childhood centres (including long daycare). The course is taught by certified professionals accredited by the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA), the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator.

Students of the course will be thoroughly prepared for the challenging environment they are entering, with the school's trainers and assessors going as far as preparing them and assisting their first steps upon entering the field. Students will be assisted and supported by their trainer/assessor in finding a suitable childcare centre for their work placement where they will gain these fundamental skills and can work with children, building on their all-around skills while gaining experience at the same time. Some of the potential roles that

the alumni can apply for include Out of School Hours assistant, Approved Family Day Care provider (from home) and Early Childhood Care and Education educators, among other starting positions.

The Sydney School of Business and Technology also offers more advanced childcare courses for those already working in the field. Their ?CHC50113 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care? fulfils this role. This course prepares anyone already working in the field with the necessary qualifications to apply for a Supervisor or Director role. The demand for people capable of filling these positions has increased over recent years, placing qualified educators at a highly coveted premium. The benefits of the position are significant, as a mid-career centre director would expect around \$31 an hour, with greater opportunities in the future. Once the course is finished, the school continues to support students who have graduated with any centres who are looking for CERT III or Diploma qualified students for vacant positions.

The local institution states that those who graduate their course are qualified to design and implement early childhood education programs. Some of the potential roles that they can apply to upon completion include Early Childhood Educator, Nominated Supervisor and Service Director/Centre Director.
