Brett Lewis explains that there was a need to launch a new website to make it user-friendly to make it easier for visitors to find the information they are looking for. This information could be provided through the articles on the blog site or through the buying guides.

One example of an article published on the blog site is one that answers the question on whether coffee becomes more acidic after a certain period of time. When coffee is allowed to sit out for longer periods of

time, there is more time for the coffee to react with oxygen, making it taste stale or more bitter. This is because oxidation increases the pH level of coffee such that it will taste less fresh. Freshly brewed coffee is considered to be the best and it is advisable to drink coffee within 30 minutes after brewing. Meanwhile, there is a difference between the pH levels in coffee as compared to coffee acidity, which affects its taste profile. Coffee usually has a pH level of approximately 5, which is slightly acidic, since a pH level of 7 is neutral. However, it is important to note that acidity in coffee does not refer to the pH level of coffee. Acidity is employed as a component of the taste profile of coffee and it is a characteristic that is considered to be desirable by coffee lovers. Coffee acidity, as such, is affected by roast type, the brewing method, and where the coffee beans grew.

First of all, it should be noted that tea is available in three main forms: loose tea leaves in an airtight packet; in tea bags; and as tea pearls. Tea that is available on store shelves often have an expiration date printed on the package. However, even after this expiration date, it does not necessarily mean that the tea has gone bad. In fact, tea leaves can't expire but they can lose their color, aroma, and flavor after a certain period of time. The expiration date is to ensure that customers get fresh tea that still have their desirable flavor and aroma. Thus, if the tea leaves have been stored properly, they may still be consumed even after the expiration date.

Another article describes how to make jasmine milk tea. Jasmine tea is manufactured by infusing dried jasmine flower blossoms into the tea leaves. And having the appropriate ingredients is vital in making jasmine milk tea. These include jasmine tea, sugar, milk or cream, a mug, a spoon, and a teapot.
