The company claims to be the best solution for septic related issues in Henrico County, Virginia. The company says that all homes that have a septic tank installed should consider regularly inspecting, pumping, and cleaning it to avoid any unforeseen emergencies. If a customer does not know whether they have a septic system installed, that information can be sourced from the realtor, the local health department or a local septic service professional. The company says that through regular use, a septic tank will encounter a build-up of solid waste over time. As the build-up increases, it accelerates leading to serious problems. The reason behind this can be the average daily disposal of human waste and toilet tissue as well as all the other unfriendly septic items.

The company says that the removal of the solid & suspended solid waste in the tank is a critical step in the septic system's care & maintenance. To extend the life of a drain field, the tank has to be pumped on a regular and consistent basis. The more frequently the septic tank is pumped, the less solid waste invades the drain field. The most important thing to know is that the industry standard is to have the septic tank pumped every 3 to 5 years. Some factors can increase or decrease the amount of time a septic tank can go without being cleaned. These factors are the number of residents who live in the home, the presence of garbage disposal in the home, the capacity (in gallons) of the septic tank, whether the septic tank been pumped on a regular and consistent basis in the past, what type of and how much toilet tissue does the household consume, and how much grease, food waste, and other unfriendly septic system products are neglectfully disposed of into the septic tank.

The company says that some states, counties, cities, and towns have strict guidelines and will instruct owners as to how often they must have their septic tank pumped. The company says that in an effort to protect the environment Chesterfield County, VA & some surrounding areas have adopted a mandatory 5-year septic tank pump-out program. Counties located within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed fall under much more stringent septic maintenance, repair & installation guidelines than other areas.

The owner of the company, Jason Muzzy, started and sold one successful pumping operation and moved away, returning to the septic industry, and starting all over. He says that his second business, Commonwealth Waste Solutions in Chester, Virginia, has generated double-digit income growth since its inception, thanks to an emphasis on customer service and septic system repairs, a boost from regional environmental regulations, and a solid work ethic.
