The versatility of this telehandler is afforded by the single telescopic boom that can be extended either upward or forward from the vehicle. Its use has been found to reduce job site operating time and expenses due to its pick and carry capability. In addition, any replacement parts that are needed while they are being used can easily be obtained within 48 hours, which significantly reduces lost time. Telehandlers are often preferred because of their capacity, cycle speeds, hydraulic hoses and electronic cables housed inside the boom for protection, cab design, boom design, safety, build, and parts availability.
