

Teeth Whitening In Walton-on-Thames Offered In Lockdown By Walton Dental Surgery

Walton Dental Surgery, a dental clinic, is offering services for teeth whitening in Walton-on-Thames for those suffering from teeth discolouration, also during the current Coronavirus lockdown. The clinic is adhering to all government guidelines for the safety of patients and staff.

The dental clinic?s services can be broadly classified as dental hygiene, dental implants, orthodontic treatments, sedation for nervous patients, and cosmetic dentistry. It also offers other general dental procedures such as regular check-ups, white fillings, crowns, root canal fillings, dentures, hygiene treatments, onlays, inlays, bridges, tooth removal, and periodontal treatments.

Teeth whitening is a common procedure performed in dental clinics. Teeth can become discolored through the continued use of certain foods such as coffee, tea, red wine, and others, or smoking tobacco, aging, trauma, and medications. Stained teeth can be an eyesore and lead to people losing their confidence in social settings. This is why teeth whitening is an often requested procedure in dental clinics. There are a few

cases in which side effects are recorded from teeth whitening such as irritation of the tooth nerves. However, this is known to be mostly temporary and only affects those with sensitive teeth.

Not all kinds of staining are the same. Some staining is reversible by bleaching such as yellowing. Brown staining is harder to remove as there may be other causes for that discoloration while grey staining may not be possible to remove at all. The best determination of this can be made by booking an appointment with the doctor who is trained to recognize the kind of staining and to recommend the correct solution.

There are a few ways to get rid of stains on teeth. One solution is the use of stain removal toothpaste. This kind of toothpaste works through mild abrasives present in the toothpaste that removes the stains by scrubbing them off. They might also contain other chemicals or agents that increase their effectiveness. This process is slow and it can take days to notice effects.

Another more popular solution is in-office bleaching at the dentist. This the kind of treatment that is being offered at Walton Dental Surgery. Teeth are whitened by applying whitening gel on the teeth through whitening trays. The gel has components that remove stains off the teeth. The end result of the treatment is pearly white teeth and a beautiful shining white smile. The clinic says that if the patient is unsure what treatment is best for them, its consultation team is always ready to answer any questions they might have. The team will conduct preliminary tests and arrive at the treatment that is the best aesthetic and clinical match for the patient?s problem. Other solutions for teeth bleaching are at-home bleaching where the dentist gives the patient a custom-made tray that is to be taken for home use. There are also over the counter bleaching products available. However, the clinic advises caution while buying them and guides patients to only select the one which is approved by a trusted authority.

The dental clinic also offers Enlighten Evolution Ice treatment which is also known as deep bleaching. This procedure takes two weeks for 95% of the patients who use it. The dentist takes a special accurate impression of the teeth and sends this to Enlighten?s lab, where new bleaching trays are made. The patient then wears these trays for 14 nights and then visits the dentist on the 15th day for a half-hour in-surgery session. The concentration of the gel used by the dentist in the Enlighten system is a quarter of the concentration of most other whitening systems. This is due to the increase in permeability by using the sealed trays. Although teeth themselves whiten, any existing fillings or crowns will remain the same color and may need replacing.
