They are designed to keep residents safe and comfortable in a familiar environment. The facility is under 24/7 supervision. This gives family members peace of mind to know that their loved ones are taken care of by the best possible measures. The facility runs structured programs and routines that are meant to keep seniors active. This promotes a healthy, balanced lifestyle while minimizing wandering behavior. The staff members are specifically trained in the pitfalls of handling someone with dementia.

Alzheimer's affects more than 5 million Americans regardless of age. More than eighty percent of those suffering from Alzheimer's are aged 75 or above and shockingly 1 in 10 people 65 and older have

Alzheimer's dementia. It is estimated that by 2050, the number of people with Alzheimer's dementia 65 and above is projected to be 13.8 million. There are no known cures and the progression of the disease is uncertain. It is the fifth leading cause of death amongst those 65 and older with an average life of 4 to 8 years after an Alzheimer's dementia diagnosis. Dementia leads to loss of mental reasoning, mobility, and muscle control. Apart from Alzheimer's, there are different types of dementia such as vascular dementia, dementia with Lewy bodies, frontotemporal dementia, Pick's disease, Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, Korsakoff syndrome, mixed dementia, and normal pressure hydrocephalus.

Memory care facilities offer amenities such as dining services which provide 3 meals for the residents taking into consideration their dietary needs and restrictions. There are laundry facilities for clean laundry and changed linens. Personal aides and nurses will help residents with eating, drinking, walking, companionship, and other tasks. Memory care homes will have scheduled social programs and activities such as art classes, game nights, and holiday parties. There are 24-hour security systems and emergency call systems to help keep residents safe from accidents. General maintenance, housekeeping, and cleaning services are provided so residents can rest and relax. Structured activities and therapy programs specifically designed to help those with memory loss. Facilities will have medical staff available to administer medication as well as treatment if needed. Memory care homes are also typically designed to help memory loss residents to familiarize themselves with the environment to lessen wandering behavior.
