These are different from assisted living facilities in that they are well-equipped with medical equipment and tools, such as dialysis machines, oxygen tanks, and electronic beds. They are also equipped to provide various kinds of services, such as memory therapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, and the like. Nursing homes offer daily meals, personal care, medication monitoring, general maintenance services including housekeeping and laundry, and activities and social programs.

There are also independent living facilities, which cater to seniors who have a strong desire to practice an independent lifestyle but their family and loved ones don't want them to be living alone and exposed to the risks of having no one to attend to them in case of an accident or illness. Seniors with ages 55 and above who are active and healthy but don't want to be burdened with the maintenance requirements of owning a home are good candidates for independent living.
