The Akron-based roofing contractor explains the amount of difficulty homeowners might experience to spot the source of the roof leak, adding, "once the water has made it through your roof, it can easily be diverted by things in your attic like insulation."

The source of stains may be difficult to locate. Just because there are stains in the kitchen doesn't mean that the leak is right above the kitchen. The top Akron roof repair contractors have the tools and expertise to investigate to find the source of that leak in the ceiling. TK Roofing and Gutters suggest taking a flashlight to the attic when it is raining to find the source of the roof leak. The idea is to look for signs of wetness when there is an active flow of water coming into the roof from the rain.

"It will take time for the wood to show water damage, but wet insulation should be an easy find. You may be able to follow a trail along a rafter or spot some droplets on the sheathing," the roof repair experts state.

Sometimes leaks are easier to find, especially those caused by fallen tree branches, age, rodents, or storms, but often they are a bit harder to spot, especially if all shingles are solid and the roof could leak "from the seal around any exhaust flashing or a plumbing vent," suggests TK Roofing and Gutters.

In some cases, a rusty nail could be the cause of the problem, adds the top Akron roofer, saying that improperly installed nails are not clearly visible. It requires an expert eye to spot such leaks.

The Ohio roof replacement company recommends using a garden hose if the weather is dry, adding that a water hose can simulate rain showers. The project requires two people, one to spray the roof and one to examine the leaks.

The idea behind this project is to witness how the roof withstands rainy conditions, suggests the Akron-based roof repair company.

Another idea to find a leak in the ceiling is to look for signs of damaged insulation. Insulation is more likely to deteriorate quicker than wood will. TK Roofing and Gutters explain how to find a leakage in the insulation and spot damages in the roof.

?Just keep in mind that if you're noticing damage on one section of the insulation, you have to remember that the leak could still be several feet in any direction because it diverted rainwater from the source of the leak.?

Another important way to spot signs of a roof leak is to check the underside of the roof for leaks, which could be caused by an object that has pierced the ceiling, suggests the Ohio roofing contractor.

?If you don't notice anything like that, look at your roof vents that are close to ridges or gable ends,? suggests Daryl Gentry, owner of the Akron roof repair company. Any wearing down of the seals around vents could result in water leaks.

The most common roof leaks are spotted in the natural weak spots in the ceiling, including chimneys, leaking vent, vent pipe, around nails, and around the skylight. TK Roofing and Gutters hints at some other structural issues that could make a roof leak, identifying ice damming as one of the trickiest types of roof leaks.

?Checking these standard weak spots is a great starting point when you're trying to find a roof leak.?
