The management says that interaction with the Scottsdale Golf Club membership is vital to its future success as it tries to live up to its reputation as the best golf course in Scottsdale. Next, the board plans to follow through with the needs as provided by the Master Plan for Improvement of Club Facilities. The first of these items is the renovation of the men's locker room and grille which are in need of updates. The board also promises to keep an ongoing line of communication with the Club members and fully utilize its advisory committees to ensure that its members are engaged at all times so that it can continue to improve in all that it does.

The Club also has a plan to tackle the effect of the COVID pandemic on its business.
