



Aaron Kosins MD Consults with the Patient Before Performing Newport Beach Breast Augmentation

He points out that while the surgery procedure and techniques can be learned while undergoing training, the idea of what makes a breast look pretty cannot. Furthermore, based on his experience, different women tend to vary with regards to what they want their breasts to look like after the surgery. He explains that his primary goal in talking with his clients first is to comprehend what his client's preferences are with regards to breast size, location of the incision, and the overall appearance of the breast, including cleavage, the fullness of the upper pole, and position of the nipple.

He explains, "Once I understand my patient's ideal breast, we can discuss the possibilities of what can be done and how to achieve our goals. The Newport Beach breast augmentation offered by Dr. Kosins has the primary goal of increasing the size of the patient's breasts, using saline or silicone implants that are placed under the muscle of the chest wall. However, he wants to remind his patients that while putting an implant under the breast tissue will enlarge the breast, it will have little effect on the breast shape and the position of the nipple-areola. By applying present technologies and techniques, he expects his patients to be able to return to their usual social activities the very same night as their breast augmentation.

Dr. Kosins also wants patients to know that there are a number of key decisions that have to be made before a primary breast augmentation. This is because this procedure will affect the patient's breasts for the rest of her life. Optimal breast size and shape has to be achieved while also balancing what the tissues will permit him to do. The maximum implant coverage for breast tissue is key, including an in-depth analysis of how the breast implant will impact the overlying breast tissue. The shapes and sizes of the implants to be chosen would depend on the quality of the breast tissue and envelope and tissue.

The incision for the breast augmentation procedure could be under the breast, in the armpit, or around the areola. Each of these incision locations have their own pros and cons, which Dr. Kosins can discuss with the patient during the consultation. The location of the incision has to allow precise dissection and maximum sterility to ensure that the patient will be able to return to her routine social activities the day after the procedure.

Another vital decision to be made is whether to use silicone or saline implants. Dr. Kosins has experience in both types of implants, including choosing between round or shaped breast implants. He wants to emphasize that breast augmentation is an outpatient procedure that is performed under general anesthesia. Most of his patients can return home after Dr. Kosins performs the procedure using the latest technologies and techniques.

Meanwhile, Dr. Kosins can also perform secondary breast procedures. Such a procedure is used to correct a number of complaints, such as deflation, implant malposition, capsular contracture, asymmetry, and implant maintenance.
