Female mosquitoes have the ability to lay up to 200 eggs or more every seven days. These eggs quickly develop from larvae into pupae, growing to adulthood in a mere nine days. One mosquito can be responsible for one billion offspring (assuming they all survive) in one month. This highlights why a mosquito control service in Great Falls is so vital? homeowners and their provider must directly address the source of the problem.

Mosquitoes are attracted inside the house by carbon dioxide exhaled by its inhabitants. Perspiration, physical movement and body warmth can also attract mosquitoes who, using their long antennae, palps and eyes, can pinpoint the location of a human or other warm-blooded animals in search of a meal. Once they have located their prey, female mosquitoes will go out in search of a meal, which they need in order to produce a batch of

eggs after mating.

Male mosquitoes are nectar-feeders and pose no biting risk, though female ones can bite multiple times in

the need to produce additional eggs. It is during this feeding cycle that mosquitoes transmit disease

organisms through their saliva into the host animal or human. Diseases that are spread to people by

mosquitoes include Zika virus, West Nile virus, Chikungunya virus, dengue and malaria.

Mitchell states, "All of these factors, plus the fact that mosquitoes will always be around us, mean you need to

be proactive about keeping your home safe from them. Our team at Backyard Bug Patrol can enhance your
